BUFFER AREA MAINTENANCE POLICY

1. <u>Definition</u> - A buffer area is defined as plant and tree growth on or between association/homeowner property and golf course property. Buffer areas do not include commons areas, wetlands, or lakes.

2. <u>Location of Buffer</u>

- a. If the buffer in question is on Association or Homeowner property, the association or homeowner must submit an application to the Architectural Committee to change any landscaping. Any approved changes must be contracted and paid for by the association or homeowner.
- b. If the buffer in question is entirely on golf course property, the association or homeowner must submit an application to the Sub-Committee on Buffer Areas. If approved the changes will be undertaken by the Golf Course Maintenance Crew within their budget.
- c. If the buffer in question is partially on both golf course and association or homeowner must submit an application to the Green Committee Sub-Committee on Buffer Areas, work is completed by the golf course maintenance crew, and the cost is shared by the association or homeowner and the budget of the golf course.
- d. Determination of location Plat Maps will be used to determine property lines.
- 3. <u>Decision on Requested Work</u> The committee will take into account the resident's needs and balance that with the golf course concerns.
- 4. <u>Further Maintenance</u>- Homeowners/Associations have the approval to regularly manage the areas already approved to their improved state. They are responsible to pay the costs of such maintenance. The golf course crew will maintain only on a can-do basis of about every two years.

PROCEDURE PROCESS FOR BUFFER ZONE REQUESTS

- 1. Persons wishing to make changes to a buffer zone should first obtain applications for ① Changes and ② Neighbors approval forms from the administrative office or online.
- 2. The request should be submitted in writing to the appropriate homeowners/condominium association President, along with a detailed description.
- 3. The Association Board should review the request and make certain that it agrees with the individual association's rules and regulations.
- 4. The written approval of the Association Board and the completed applications are taken to the Administration Office and then forwarded to the Buffer Zone and Green Committee chairs.
- 5. After Committee approval, an email from the Green Committee Chair / Vice Chair is your official copy of approval. A copy will be kept on file in the Administrative Office.
