**USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES.**

Boundaries

- A. Out of Bounds: Defined by White Stakes and the edge of the street curb.
- B. Lateral Water Hazard: Defined by RED stakes or lines.
- C. RED lines on cart paths also define the margin of the hazard.
- D. Water Hazard: Defined by YELLOW stakes or lines.
  - 1. A ball crossing a road and ending up on another hole is Out of Bounds.
  - 2. Holes #1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 11 & 18 are (ESA) environmentally sensitive areas: Defined by signage and are marked as Lateral Hazards. These areas are defined by the inside edge of the RED stakes with GREEN top. These areas are RESTRICTED AREAS, do not enter these areas to retrieve or search for golf balls.
  - 3. Holes #4, 9, 12 & 13 DROP CIRCLES are for balls that are hit into the lake.
  - 4. 'SHELL' and 'PINE STRAW' areas are an integral part of the course and the ball must be played as it lies.
  - 5. Exception: Hole #6 shell path to the right of the green is deemed a cart path, free drop.
  - 6. Holes #9 & 13 shell areas are considered 'WASTE BUNKERS'. The ball must be played as it lies and you may ground the club.
  - 7. Holes #7, 10, 11 & 15 'BULKHEADS' interfering with stance or swing is considered immovable obstructions, free drop.
  - 8. Holes #12, 13 & 14 drainage culverts are deemed 'Ground Under Repair' and will be marked with BLUE stakes.
  - 9. The Embedded Ball will be played through the green. (RULE 25-2)
  - 10. Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. (RULE 24-1)
  - 11. 'FLOWER BEDS' are ground under repair and marked with a BLUE stake, free drop.

**AVOID SLOW PLAY:** When you have an open hole in front of you, allow faster players to play through.

**PLEASE:** Repair Ball Marks, Fill Divots with Sand and Rake Bunkers.

**LIGHTNING ADVISORY:** One Long Siren-Dangerous Condition-Exit Course; Three Intermittent Sounds-Resume Play

**EMERGENCY PHONES:** Located in the rest room between Holes 4-5 & 14-15.
